What the heck is a RoundTable?

In the past few months the RE has been mentioning this RoundTable deal over and over. He has been asking for the membership to help with the event when it happens on March 14-16th, 2008. But he never has actually explained what a RoundTable is, now has he?

So here it is:

The Northeast Division of the SCCA (NeDiv) has two Divisional Meetings every year. These events are hosted by the various regions that make up NeDiv, as a service to our club as a whole.

In the Fall is the **MiniCon**, so called as it is before the National Convention. The main purpose of the MiniCon is to plan for the upcoming years events, set the schedule throughout the division, set up Regional and Divisional Series and approve divisional-wide classes. There are also seminars for Club Racing, Solo, Rally, Specialties, etc.

In the Spring is the **RoundTable**, so called because....well, I am not sure, other than it had to be called something, and we usually sit at round tables I guess. Anyways, the main purpose of the RoundTable is to train, update and get everyone started up for that year's events. At a RoundTable, there are usually seminars for the Specialties, Drivers (Solo, Club Racing, and Rally), Stewards and other members, as well as some offerings from racing related businesses. Members can attend the full weekend (with lunches, dinner, etc.) or just the seminars.
