The 63rd Glen Nationals

Attached are the results of the 63rd Glen Nationals, presented by the Glen Region SCCA, Inc. This event was held on the 3.4 mile Watkins Glen International road course July 9-11, 2010 in Watkins Glen, NY. The national races were run under sanction numbers 10-N-1117-S and 10-N-1118-S.

There were 312 cars on course divided into seven groups. The grids for Saturday afternoon's 14 lap races were determined by the best time run in a 25 minute qualifying session Friday morning and a 15 minute qualifying session Saturday morning. The grids for Sunday afternoon's 14 lap races were determined by the best time run in a 25 minute qualifying session Sunday afternoon and a 15 minute qualifying session Sunday morning. Temperatures were in the high 80's and low 90's on Friday under sunny skies, and in the high 80's Saturday under partly cloudy skies. Sunday's temperatures were in the mid-80's with clear skies, and all sessions were run on a dry track.

The AMB transponder system was used for timing the qualifying sessions, and scoring for the races was accomplished with two independent lapcharts. There were 15 workers in Timing & Scoring representing the Glen, Central NY, Finger Lakes, New England, New York, Philadelphia, Washington DC, and Western NY SCCA regions.
